ABOUT

"Feeding Carroll Together," is a county-wide food drive that unites the food pantries of Carroll County in the fight against hunger. This collaborative effort aims to alleviate food insecurity and provide support to those in need throughout the summer months.

FAQ

Q: What is Feeding Carroll Together?

A: Feeding Carroll Together is a county-wide collaboration to combat hunger in Carroll County, Maryland. It aims to alleviate food insecurity and provide support to those in need throughout the summer months.

Q: When do these food drives take place?

A: The food drive is starting now—because the need is urgent—and running throughout the summer months.

Q: How can I participate?

A: There are several ways to participate:

- Donate non-perishable food items to your local food pantry. To locate your closest food pantry, we
 invite you to visit http://bit.ly/ccfreefood.
- Volunteer your time at a food pantry.
- Spread the word about #FeedingCarrollTogether through social media and community networks.

Q: What kind of food items should I donate?

A: Non-perishable food items are highly encouraged. Canned vegetables, fruits, protein-rich items, and other nutritious staples are especially valuable donations. You may also check with your local food pantry to see what food they are in need of.

Q: Can I donate money instead of food items?

A: Monetary donations are always welcome, but this drive is focused on food because food donations are so low during the summer months. Please contact your local food pantry for more information.

A: You can spread the word by:

- Sharing information about the food drive on your social media accounts.

DONATION GUIDELINES

FOOD COLLECTION

- Collect shelf stable food and store in a "food safe" area, away from chemicals and six inches off the ground, out of the reach of pests.
- Check the expiration dates on the donated items.
- Focus on nutritious staples like canned vegetables, fruits, and protein-rich items.
- Please do not donate opened or homemade food items.

SCHEDULE DROP-OFF

To ensure someone is available to receive your donation please reach out to your local food pantry to schedule your drop off. To locate your closest food pantry, we invite you to visit http://bit.ly/ccfreefood.

VOLUNTEER INFORMATION

If you are interested in volunteering at a food pantry, please contact your local food pantry or visit their website for more information on volunteer opportunities. They will provide you with the necessary details and guidelines.


